DRIVING WHILE SUSPENDED AMENDMENT INFORMATION

You **MAY** be eligible to have this charge amended to a lesser offense if you complete the below requirements and are approved by a City Prosecutor. If you are interested in amending your Driving While Suspended charge, the following items **must be completed no later than 90 days from the date of offense.**

** Please be advised that the amendment fee is \$150, plus court costs, and is due in one payment at the time of the amendment. **

PLEASE NOTE: If your license has been suspended for an alcohol related event (i.e. failure or refusal of a breath test, MIP, DUI, etc.) you are not eligible for an amendment.

- Get your driver's license reinstated. Call or go online to see why you are suspended.**

Driver's licenses are often suspended for failing to appear in court, failing to pay fines and fees, failure to provide proof of mandatory insurance, in addition to other reasons. Your driving privileges must be reinstated prior to obtaining an amendment.

- Bring proof of reinstatement and money/credit card to pay the amendment fee and court costs to your next court date. This must be completed no later than 90 days from the date of offense.**
