NO PROOF OF INSURANCE AMENDMENT INFORMATION

If you did not have insurance coverage at the time of the ticket, you **MAY** be eligible to have this charge amended to a lesser offense, if you complete the below requirements and are approved by a City Prosecutor. If you are interested in amending your No Proof of Insurance charge, the following items **must be completed no later than 60** days from the date of offense.

** Please be advised that the amendment fee is \$100, plus court costs, and is due in one payment at the time of the amendment. **

Obtain current liability insurance coverage for yourself or your vehicle.

If you no longer own a vehicle, you may purchase a non-owner's insurance policy that will cover you as the driver of another's vehicle.

□ Bring proof of insurance and money/credit card to pay for fines and fees to your next court date. <u>This must be completed no later than 60 days from the date of offense.</u>

IF YOU WERE INVOLVED IN AN ACCIDENT:

Proof of Restitution or Letter of Release required in cases involving an accident.

If you were involved in an accident at the time of your ticket, you will be required to show proof of restitution for damages to the other party involved, or a letter signed by the other party releasing you from any liability for the accident.

If you desire to amend your No Proof of Insurance charge to a lesser offense, the assessed fine is generally 100 + court costs, and must be paid in full at the time of amendment.
