



Lenexa Fire Department Blasting Checklist



Blasting within the City of Lenexa must be conducted in accordance with the applicable section of the 2018 International Fire Code, Article 3-6-B of the Lenexa City Code, and regulations adopted by the State of Kansas, K.A.R. 22-4-5/N.F.P.A. 495.

The following information is collected for processing of a Blasting Permit, in the City of Lenexa:

- LFD Blasting Permit Application
- Certificate of Insurance Policy Minimums:
 - General Liability of \$500,000
 - Each Occurrence
 - Damage to Rented Premises
 - Medical Expense
 - Personal & Adv. Injury
 - General Aggregate
 - Automobile Liability
 - Excess Umbrella Liability
 - Worker's Comp/Employer Liability
 - City of Lenexa named as insured
- Plot Plan
- Blasting Plan detailing materials used and seismic reading limits (1.0 PPV Limit in Lenexa)
- ATF License for Storage and Transport
- Copy of State Licenses for each person involved in the blasting process:
 - KSFMO Blaster License
 - User License
 - Driver Licenses
- Storage License from KSFMO. Complete all applicable section of this form, regardless if explosives are stored on site.
- Mapped illustration of property notification within 500-foot and 1,000-foot radius, respectively.
 - Conducted survey details for properties within 500 feet.
- KS One Call - utility notification and response details.
- Seismograph Calibration Certificates (current annual calibration)
- Applicable Lenexa Permit Number (LD, SS, etc.)
- \$500 Permit Fee Payment

Blasting permits are valid for a specified thirty-day period. Extensions will be considered on an individual basis. Extensions will not be approved if delays are avoidable or manageable by the permit holder.

LFD Prevention maintains discretion to witness any blasting procedure. Notification must be provided within a minimum of 24 hours prior to blasting. Seismic readings must be submitted within 24 hours following each blast.
